1.05 CLERK TO KEEP COPY. The County Clerk for Dane County shall permanently keep on file and open to public inspection a copy of the Dane County Code of Ordinances.

1.06 EFFECTIVE DATE. The county clerk shall provide at no cost electronic updates to the Code of Ordinances at regular intervals.

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Dane does ordain as follows:

Chapter 1 of the Dane County Ordinances is created to read as follows:

1.01 AUTHORITY. This ordinance is enacted under the authority of section 66.035, Wis. Stats., 1977.

1.02 PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to simplify, clarify and collect the various ordinances of Dane County into one coherent code for ease of reference and usage.

1.03 CODE OF ORDINANCES. There is hereby created for the County of Dane a code of ordinances to be known as the "Dane County Ordinances" and consisting of all those ordinances now in existence and on file in the office of the Dane County Clerk.

1.04 CITATIONS TO THE CODE. Citations to the code of ordinances shall be in one of the following forms:

- (1) "Section __, Dane County Ordinances";
- (2) "Section __, D. C. Ords.";
- (3) "Section _____, Dane County Code of Ordinances".
